



## YHA Keswick - Access Statement

### Introduction

If you're looking to stay in the Lake District, but fancy something close to town, then YHA Keswick is ideal! The hostel is right in the centre of Keswick and boasts a beautiful riverside location overlooking the River Greta. We make a great base for walking, climbing and cycling; there is easy access from the hostel to routes for all abilities.

We aim to cater for the needs of all visitors in this 85-bed hostel; a 4-storey building Situated on the banks of the river Greta. Unfortunately none of our bedrooms or bathrooms is accessible to modern standards.

### Pre-Arrival

- The nearest rail station is Penrith which is 18.5 miles away.
- The nearest bus stop is within 300 metres of the hostel. There is a frequent bus service which runs to this stop.
- The roads in Keswick are fairly level but can become steep in places. The hostel is located right on the waterfront. From Station Road there are a set of 18 concrete steps down to the riverside with a handrail to one side. There is then a level concrete walkway leading 50m to the hostel.

### Car Parking and Arrival

Unfortunately due to our location we do not have any parking onsite. There is road side parking on Station Road, but this is restricted to two hours during the day. There is pay and display parking within 600 metres of the hostel on Victoria Street. The road from here is level until the river and has a pavement and street lighting.

From the road there are 18 steep steps with handrails down to the Riverside walkway. If you let us know what time you are coming we will do our best to provide assistance moving to and from cars.

### Main Entrance and Reception

From the riverside walkway there is one step up into the hostel, through manual, double doors which open inwards into the entrance hall. The flooring in here is ceramic floor tiles

and carpet. There is level access from here, through another set of double doors, into the reception.

There is laminate flooring in the reception area. The reception counter is low-level. An emergency telephone is also available in this area; this is to contact a member of staff during the night.

## Public Areas

### Halls, Corridors and Stairs

There is good colour contrast to floor, walls and doorways throughout the building. All public areas, halls, stairs and landings are well lit using a combination of ceiling and wall lights. On the ground floor the corridors are surfaced with ceramic floor tiles. On the upper floors the corridors have carpet flooring.

There is no lift at YHA Keswick, so access to upper floors is via stairs only. The stairs are carpeted and have a handrail fitted to one side. Circulation on each individual floor is level.

### Public WCs

There is a unisex WC on the ground floor which contains grab rails (door width 780mm). However, it does not meet modern accessible standards. The flooring is non-slip and there is good lighting.

### Lounge

Our lounge is located on the first floor. There are 19 steps to this floor. From here there is level access through a single leaf door. The lounge is a large, bright room, with carpet flooring.

The room is furnished with coffee tables, sofas and armchairs. All furniture can be moved; please just ask at reception if you require assistance.

The smaller reading room is just across the corridor and is similarly furnished.

### Dining Room

The dining room is located on the ground floor and has level access from the entrance hall via double doors. The floor is level and the room is well-lit. The flooring is wooden parquet and carpet.

There are dining tables and straight backed chairs without armrests. All furniture can be moved; please just ask at reception if you require assistance.

Table service is available; please ask at reception and we will be happy to help. We are also happy to cater for dietary requirements or any particular likes or dislikes. Please advise us of these before your arrival.

### Self-Catering Kitchen

The self-catering kitchen is located on the first floor. There are 19 steps to this floor. From here there is level access through a single leaf door. The floor is level and surfaced with non-slip lino. The room is well-lit with ceiling lights.

The self-catering kitchen is fully equipped, with: Ovens with grills and hobs, utensils, crockery, cutlery, cups and glasses. Crockery and some kitchen equipment are kept in high shelving units. We would be happy to move these to lower storage if required.

### Laundry and Drying Facilities

The laundry and drying rooms are located on the second floor. There are 15 steps up to this floor from the first floor. From here there is level access through a single leaf door. The flooring in each room is non-slip lino and they are well-lit.

Here we have a coin operated washing machine and dryer. There is also an ironing board and iron available for guests to use.

### Bedrooms and Bathrooms

None of the rooms is en-suite, but they do all have a washbasin. Unless otherwise stated, all bedrooms have bunk beds. All bedrooms are carpeted and well-lit with ceiling and individual bunk lights. All bedding is provided.

All of the bathrooms have fluorescent lighting and non-slip flooring. The standard showers have a step up to enter.

### First Floor

There are 19 steps up to:

- One 2-bedded room
- One 3-bedded room (double with a single over)
- Two 4-bedded rooms
  
- Two WCs and two showers

### Second Floor

There are 15 steps up to:

- One 3-bedded room
- Three 4-bedded rooms
- Four 6-bedded rooms
  
- Four WCs and four showers

### Third Floor

There are 16 steps up to:

- Five 3-bedded rooms
- Two 4-bedded rooms
- Two 5-bedded rooms
- Four WCs and six showers

### Grounds and Garden

Unfortunately due to our location we do not have any ground or gardens.

### Cycle Shed

The Cycle shed is located to the rear of the building, along a concrete alley. There is a step down from the hostel to the alley and a gentle slope to the cycle shed.

### Additional Information

- We do not permit pets, but assistance dogs are very welcome.
- We do not permit smoking anywhere in the hostel.
- A member of staff is always available on site, including at night (access via emergency phone at Reception and in the corridor on each floor).
- Emergency lighting and fire alarms fitted. We ensure that all guests are evacuated in the event of fire or any emergency requiring evacuation. Arrangements for guests needing assistance to evacuate in case of fire should be discussed beforehand.
- Evacuation procedures are displayed in each bedroom.
- Mobile phone reception varies in the hostel; O2 and Orange get good signal, other operators get poor/no signal.
- Wi-Fi is available at this hostel.
